

Background

Edward is a freelance art critic and editor, living and working between Japan and China. His writing focuses on contemporary art in the Asian context, focusing on

- alternative cultural practices
- independent art groups
- sound in art

Edward received a bachelor's degree in Fine Art at Middlesex University in London (graduated 1994), a Post-Graduate Diploma in Contemporary Art History at Goldsmiths College, London (graduated 2006), and an MA in Global Arts at Goldsmiths College, London (graduated with distinction 2014).

In 2007 Edward moved to China to found and co-curate CPU:798, a photography and new media project space in Beijing. He was responsible for overall programming, publicity, and curation of shows in the space and was manager of its day-to-day functions.

Since 2009 Edward has regularly contributed reviews and features about contemporary art in China to a wide range of print and online publications. He has also curated exhibitions on this subject, and has provided writing and editorial services to local and international individuals, institutions, and publications.

In September 2018 Edward will begin a research PhD at Hong Kong Baptist University, for which he will develop his research into sound art and experimental music in Mainland China and Hong Kong.

李蔼德在伦敦密德萨斯大学获得艺术学士学位 (1994年毕业), 并在伦敦金史密斯学院获得学士后当代艺术史文凭 (2006年毕业) 及全球性艺术硕士学位 (2014年以优异成绩毕业)。

2007年, 李蔼德在国内成立CPU: 798画廊。这画廊是一所798艺术区内集摄影和新媒体于一身的项目空间。他负责总体规划, 策展和展览的宣传。

自2009年, 李蔼德开始自由艺术评论家和策展人的工作。他曾与国内画廊及机构共同策划了一系列国内及国际艺术家的展览。他是许多有关于中国当代艺术评论和专题文章的印刷刊物和线上出版物的定期撰稿人, 并曾对国内及国外人士、机构和出版物提供写作和编辑服务。

从2018年9月开始, 李蔼德将在香港浸会大学攻读博士学位, 并开展他对中国大陆和香港声音艺术和实验音乐的研究。
